### MAWA President Nomination Form

**Nomination forms must be received at the MAWA Office by the end of business, two days before the AGM.**

Persons prohibited from nominating for MAWA President position.
-----------------------------------------------------------------

Under the 2015 Association Act, the following people will be prohibited from sitting on the Board of MAWA (without prior approval by the Commissioner for Consumer Protection) if they:

1. are an undischarged bankrupt or their affairs are under insolvency laws;
2. have been convicted of an offence in connection with the promotion, formation or management of a body corporate;
3. have been convicted of an offence involving fraud or dishonesty punishable on conviction by at least three months or more imprisonment;
4. have been convicted of an offence under Division 3 (the duties of officers provisions) or section 127 (the duty with respect to incurring of debt) of the Act.

Where a person is prohibited because they have been convicted of an offence, they cannot be a MAWA Board Director for a period of five years from their conviction, except where the conviction resulted in imprisonment, in which case they cannot be a MAWA Board Director for five years from their release from custody.
